



Course Rules

We expect and hope that all students registered on Bath Tutorial College courses will have an experience to remember and, for their part, will make every effort to show respect at all times to fellow students and members of Bath Tutorial College staff.

The course rules outlined below are designed to ensure that all students and staff of Bath Tutorial College are able to enjoy their course, free from any inappropriate, unpleasant, intimidating or aggressive behaviour and, thus, in complete safety.

The breach of any course rule stated below may result in dismissal from the course. Furthermore, any student who breaks the law or displays aggressive, intimidating or racist behaviour will face instant dismissal from the course. Should a student face instant dismissal, the student will be withdrawn from the course with immediate effect and will need to return home at their parent or guardian's expense at the earliest possible opportunity.

1. Students are expected to attend all meals and classes.
2. All damage to property, equipment and rooms will be charged to the student.
3. Consumption or possession of alcohol by students of any age is not permitted and will result in dismissal from the course.
4. Drug-taking or possession of drugs including Psychoactive Substances (in the UK formally known as legal highs) will result in instant dismissal from the course.
5. Smoking is not permitted. (*It is illegal for anyone under the age of 18 years to purchase or smoke cigarettes or other tobacco products.*)
6. Racist, bullying or intimidating behaviour towards another student or member of staff will result in dismissal from the course.
7. Male and female students must not enter each other's accommodation facilities.
8. Students must not leave the campus without notice or the house parents' permission.
9. Any student who leaves their house after 'lights out' may be dismissed from the course.



10. Mobile phones & other personal electronic devices must not be used in lessons unless they are required for academic purposes.
11. Electronic gaming devices (such as PSPs) and MP3 players (such as iPods) must be kept in the boarding houses. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in the confiscation of the device for the duration of the course.
12. Bath Tutorial College reserves the right to search a student's room if it is suspected they are breaking any of the course rules.
